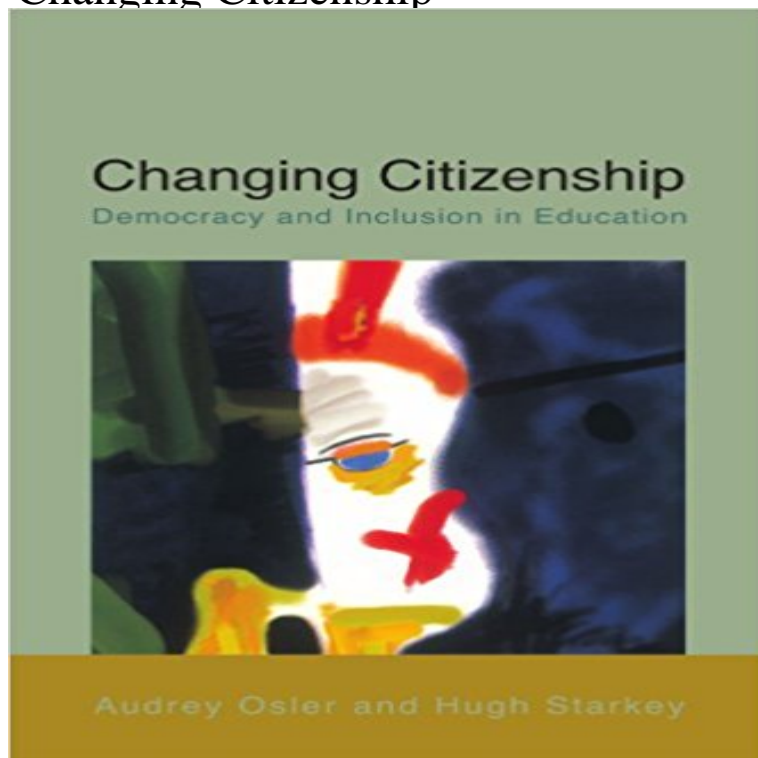


Changing Citizenship



How can citizenship in schools meet the needs of learners in multicultural and globalized communities? Citizenship can serve to unite a diverse population, or to marginalise and exclude. With the introduction of citizenship in school curricula, there is an urgent need for developing the concept of cosmopolitan and inclusive citizenship. It explores the role that schools can play in creating a new vision of citizenship for multicultural democracies.
