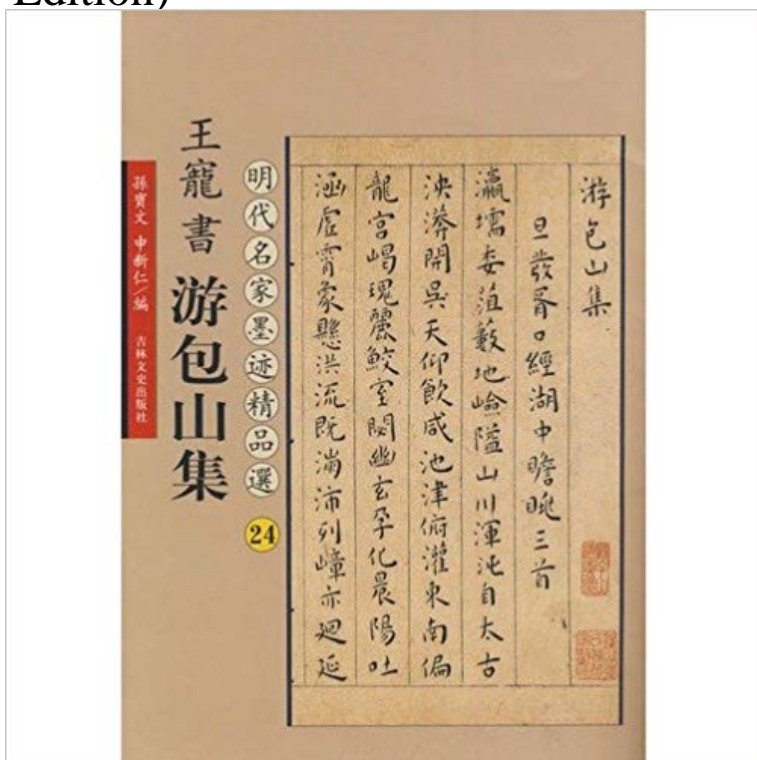


Wang Chongs poems of travelling the Baoshan mountain - representative selection of the master calligraphers in Ming dynasty-24 (Chinese Edition)



Wang Chong(1494-1533), the famous calligrapher of Ming dynsty, Zi Lvren and changed it to Yulvji later, Hao Yayishanren, was born in Changzhou(Suzhou nowadays). He had took part in the imperial examination repeatedly but never got any official rank.However, he made great achievement in calligraphy. He Liangjun of Ming dynasty had spoken highly of Wang Chongs works. Its a pity that Wang Chong died at an early age of 40. In 1527, he transcribed 25 poems created during his travel in Baoshan mountain eight years ago and sent to his friend Buyanjushi who liked it so much. The well-known calligrapher Wen Peng also commented that this collection was the best one of Wang Chong among all his works.
