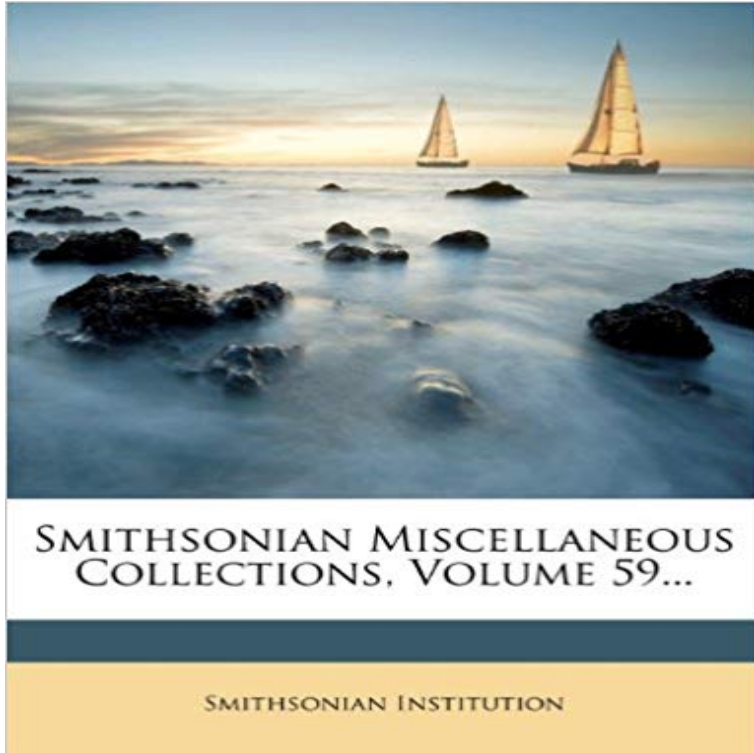


## Smithsonian Miscellaneous Collections, Volume 59...
