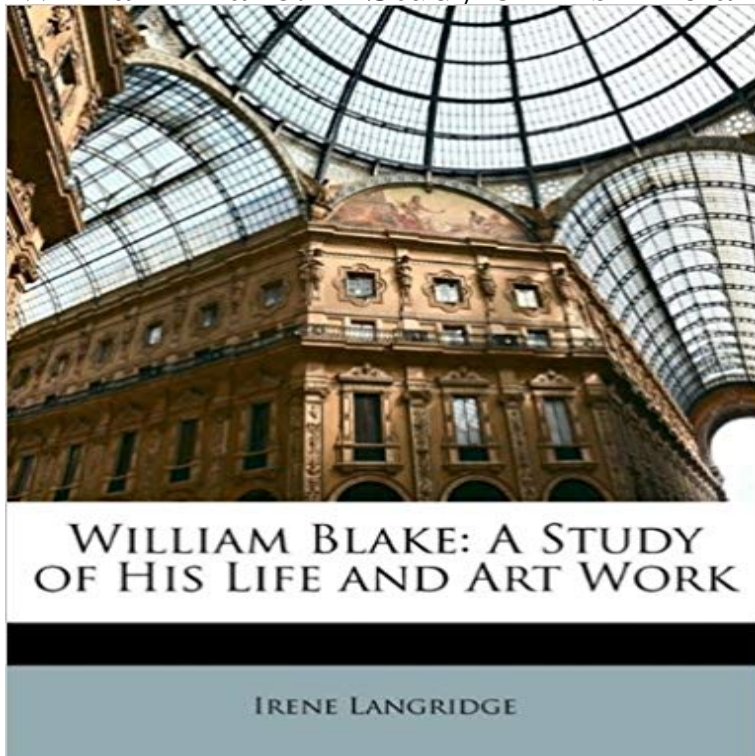


William Blake: A Study of His Life and Art Work
